Scholarship Description

This scholarship supports Master of Learning Intervention (Deaf Education) students to develop specialist skills and knowledge to become a teacher of the deaf. The scholarship is worth up to \$30,000 in total across the two-year duration of the course.

Applicants with an interest in the education of students who are deaf/hard of hearing in Victoria are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship you need to:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- be enrolled, or intend to enrol, in the [Master of Learning Intervention \(Deaf Education\)](#). Ensure you meet the entry requirements for the course prior to applying for the scholarship.

Applicants must not be in receipt of the [Inclusive Education Grant](#).

All scholarship offers will be made under the condition that applicants commit to commence their Master of Learning Intervention (Deaf Education) studies at the University of Melbourne in Semester 1, 2025. **Benefits** The successful applicant will receive a scholarship valued at \$30,000. This will be paid in twice annual instalments over the duration of the course.

Selection Criteria

- Evidence of strong teaching practice
- A strong interest in working with students who are deaf or hard of hearing
- Knowledge of quality inclusive learning and teaching practices and differentiation
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a team
- Well developed communication and interpersonal skills with the capacity to build relationships and engage students, colleagues and parents
- Relevant professional teaching experience will be regarded positively.

1. In the first instance, interested applicants should check they meet the [Master of Learning Intervention entry requirements](#) and submit a course application for this program.
2. Complete this scholarship application form and attach relevant documentation.
Scholarships applications will close at 11:59 PM on 1 December, 2024.
3. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an interview in early December. All applicants will be notified of an outcome by mid-December.
